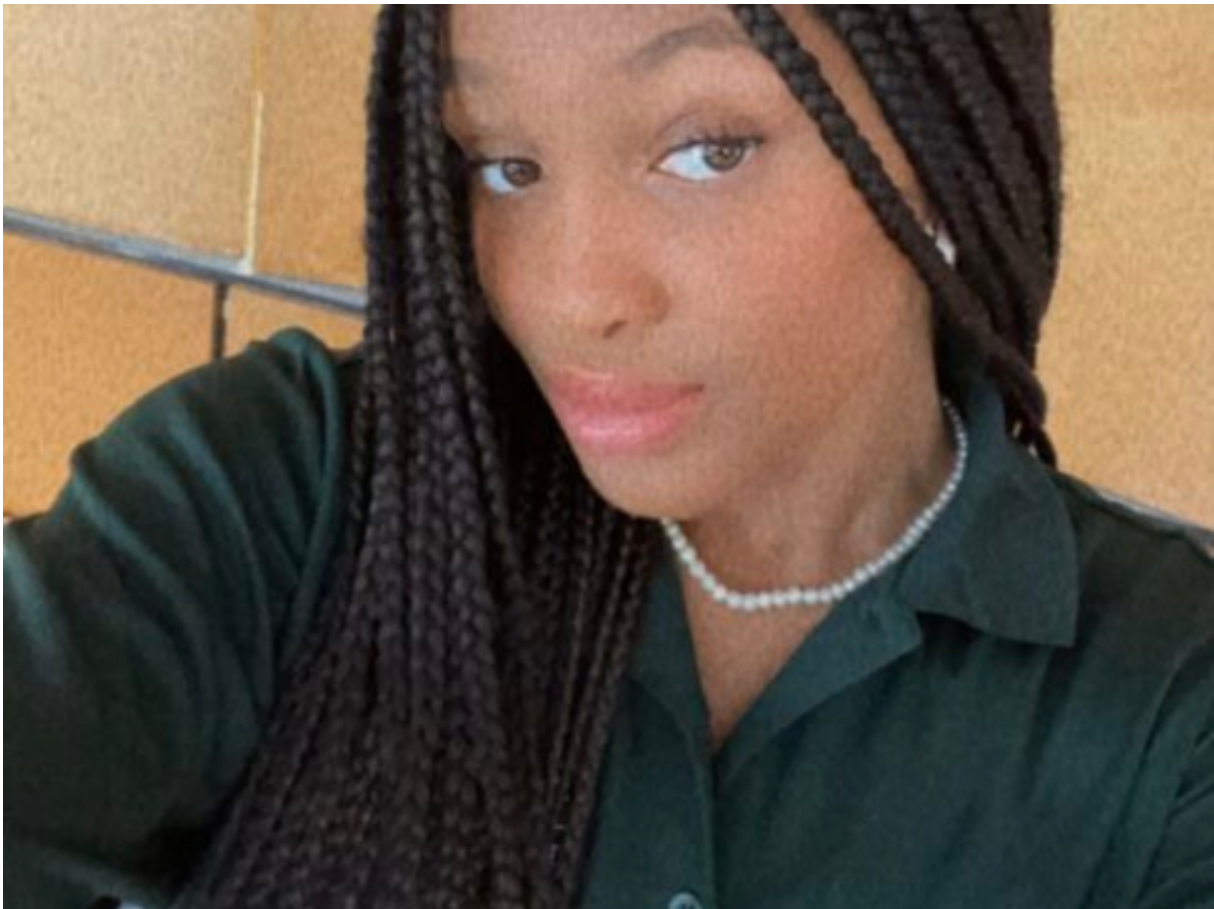


Grassroots Organizing With SisterLove
