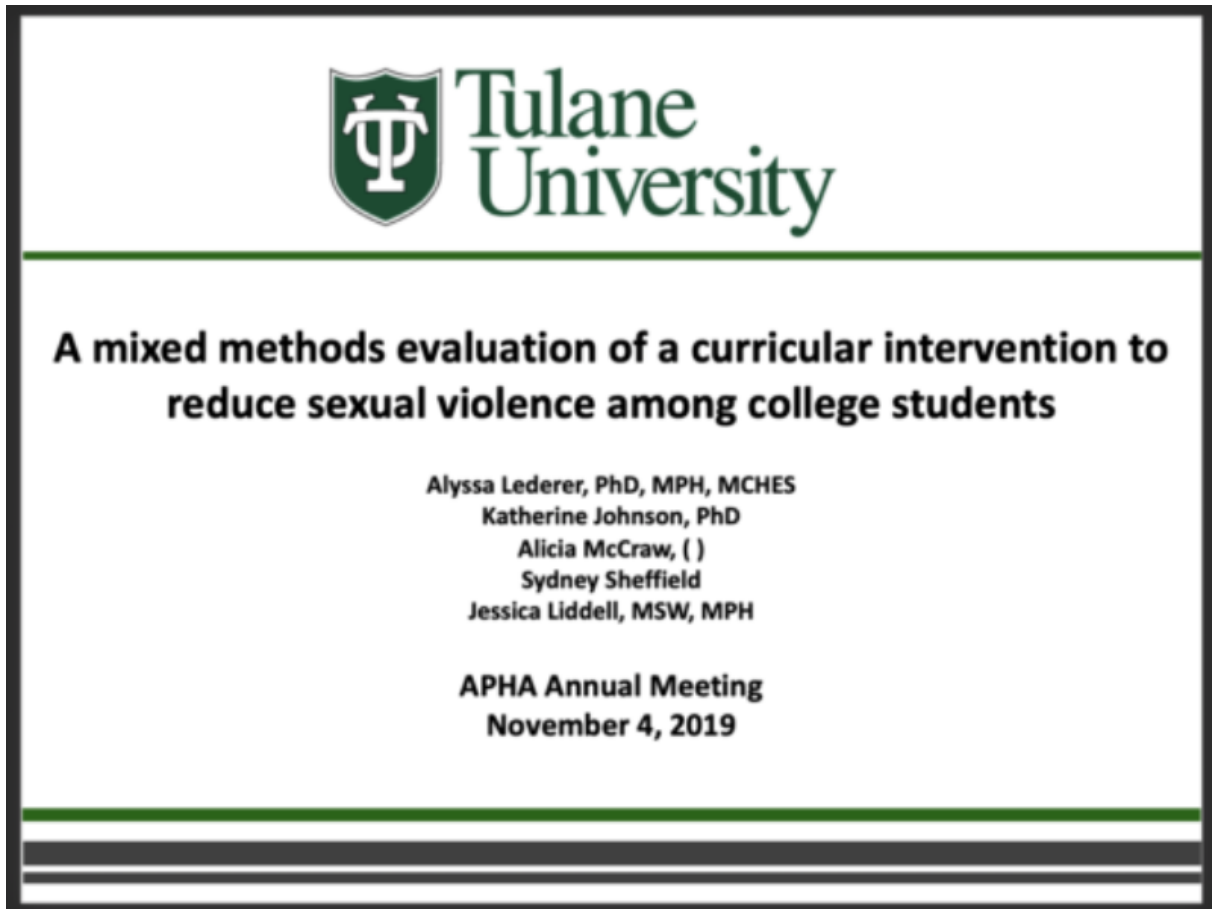


# Diving into Dissemination!

My name is Sydney, and this past summer, I continued work on Dr. Katherine Johnson's and Dr. Alyssa Lederer's study investigating whether a new course in the Gender and Sexuality Studies department could serve as an effective intervention for changing Tulane's climate regarding sexuality, sexual health, and sexual violence.
