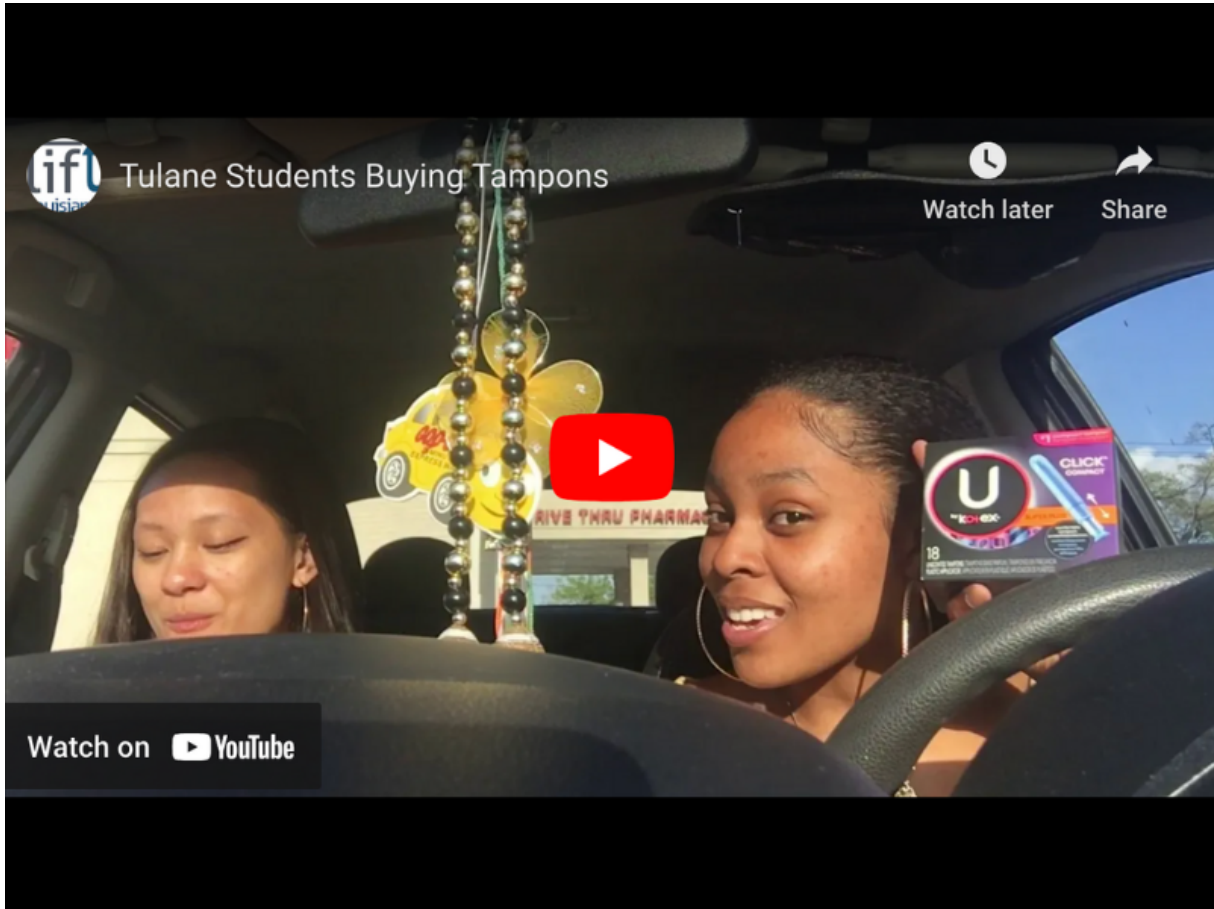


New Year... Even Better Me!
