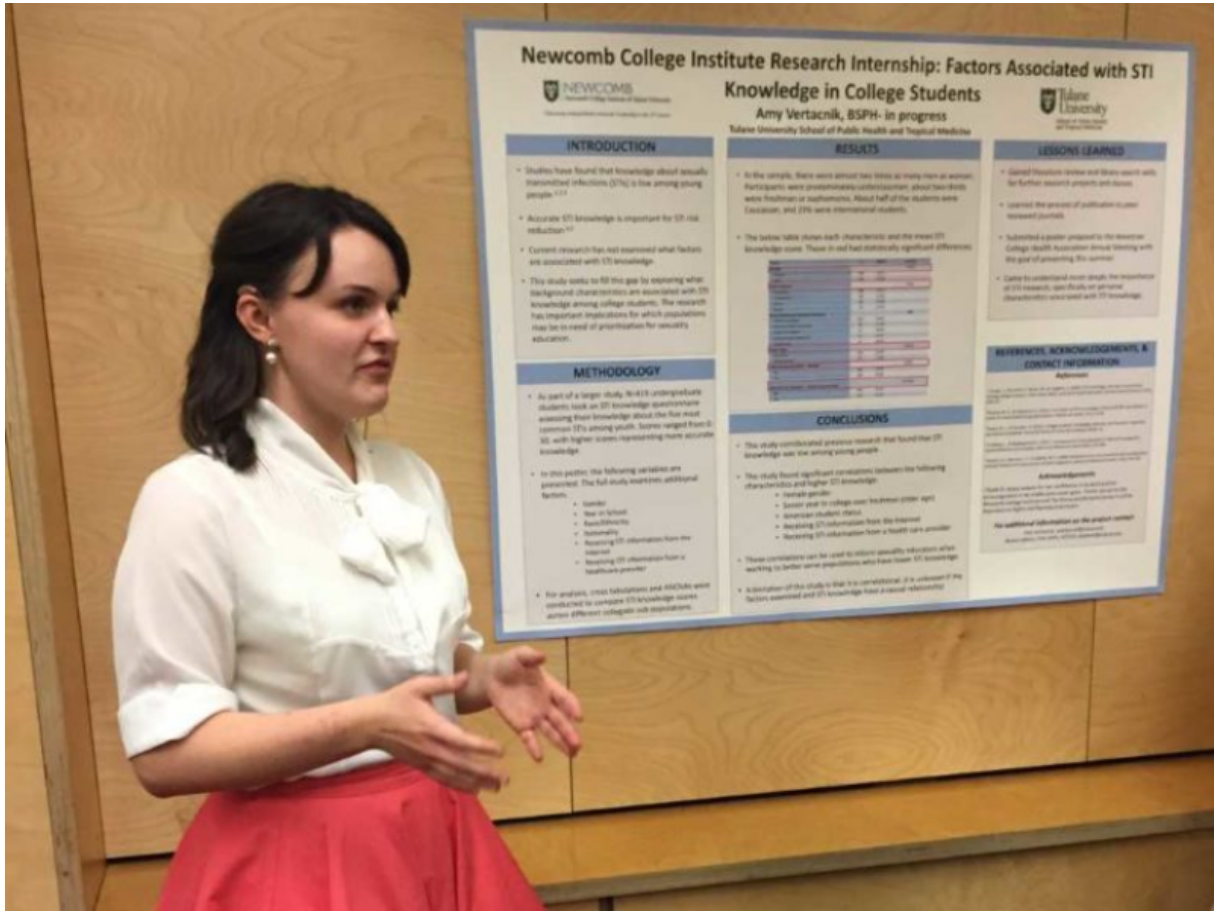


Closing Out With A Bang!
